Happy New Year to All SMDS Members! January 10, 2018, marks the start of 438th Session of the Maryland General Assembly. Session lasts for 90 calendar days as our elected officials consider more than 2,500 pieces of legislation. At our December 4th General Membership meeting, guest Delegate Bonnie Cullison (District #19 Montgomery County) announced that she will once again this year propose a bill allowing dental therapists to provide dental care in Maryland. Many in the audience were shocked and dismayed by her announcement. At least we know where she stands on the issue however misguided and misinformed. Fake news and deliberate misinformation seems to be



the order of the day. An example is the January 2nd Chicago Tribune Article entitled "Commentary: One Change to dental Care that could save lives, money". The article generalizes that "America lacks sufficient dental care providers", "voters are in favor" of dental therapists, and "allowing dental therapists to practice would remove an unnecessary government barrier to dental services...". I'm personally not sure what barriers they are referring to in the article. It seems to me one big barrier is the lack of any Adult Medicaid or Medicare dental benefits. Adding dental therapists does not address these barriers at all. I'm getting very tired of misleading questions in public opinion surveys that leave out the background facts so important in proper decision making. The Deamonte Driver death over 10 years ago was a grave tragedy but there were a large number of systemic failures that occurred, including a dysfunctional child Medicaid system at the time. Since that time, the Maryland Healthy Smiles Program has received national recognition as a model for the nation. To singularly blame the dental profession is simply wrong!

Nobody knows dentistry and our patients' needs better than Maryland practicing dentists, particularly ADA members. It is time we drown out the voices of "out-of-towners" who think the Minnesota dental therapist model is the best thing Maryland needs. I have attached to this article two short and concise summaries on why dental therapy is a bad idea in Maryland. One is a Q & A the MSDA has developed. The other is a 2016 letter to The Wall Street Journal by Jane Grover, DDS, MPH, entitled "The Hidden Perils of Non-Dentist Dentistry". Dr. Grover is Director of the ADA Council on Access, Prevention, and Interprofessional Relations.

What can YOU do as an MSDA member?

Read the attached information and become extremely knowledgeable on the topic of dental therapy. Share your knowledge with your colleagues and patients. We are all voters in this democracy!

- Reach out to the key legislators who sit on committees that hear bills related to dentistry. The list of key Delegates and Senators from Montgomery County and Prince Georges County are listed below. It is preferable to call, tell them you are a constituent and set up an in-person meeting. At a minimum, call them and e-mail them and tell them you oppose dental therapists in Maryland. Much better solutions to solving the dental "access to care" problem are reinstating an adult Medicaid dental benefit in Maryland, emergency department diversions of patients who present with dental issues, and increased utilization of Community Dental Health Coordinators (CDHC). At this time, we do not have bill #'s but it is not to early to have this discussion. After your discussion, send a hand-written note with your business card. Include a request to contact you should they need any additional information about dentistry.
- Check your e-mail inbox and SMDS Facebook Page for alerts on legislative actions and potential MSDA Webinars on CDHC's and pre- "Dentist Day in Annapolis" information.
- RSVP and attend our next important SMDS General Membership meeting Monday, February 5. Dr. Natalia Chalmers will present the Maryland Dental Action Coalition's legislative study on Emergency Room Diversions and support for Adult Dental Medicaid.
- Register and attend MSDA's Dentist Day in Annapolis Wednesday, February 21. It will be a great opportunity to learn all the legislative issues and an opportunity to meet with your legislators. Link to register: <u>http://www.msda.com/dentist-day.php</u>
- I realize that I am asking a lot of each one of you and I thank you in advance for heeding the call and taking action. As you can see from the list of ten individuals below, Montgomery and Prince Georges Counties have a large proportion of the key legislators that make health care decisions. Don't be afraid to talk with these legislators. We elected them to office and now they represent us. It is imperative that they know what is important to us and our patients' oral health.
- We are faced with outside forces that want to change the quality of dental care for the patients we care for. Stand up and let your voice be heard!

The Hidden Perils of Non-Dentist Dentistry

Poor children shouldn't be stopped from seeing a dentist by a restructured system that redirects them to providers with less training than dentists.

Many challenges keep people from visiting a dentist including lack of oral health education, cost, fear of the dentist, and a belief that they don't need care. Dental therapists have failed to show meaningful results in addressing these barriers.

A handful of states created this provider to treat underserved patients, especially in rural areas. But these patients are more likely to have complex dental disease and health issues that require the skill and training of a dentist to diagnose and treat.

Despite the best intentions of connecting dental therapists to needier rural populations, they primarily practice in metropolitan areas.

Nationally, children have seen improvements in dental access with the gap in utilization between lowincome children and high-income children narrowing in 49 states.

Poor children shouldn't be stopped from seeing a dentist by a restructured system that redirects them to providers with less training than dentists. In Michigan, 80 percent of dentists participate in Healthy Kids Dental for Medicaid enrolled children. The proposed therapist model tries to fix a system that isn't broken, relegating disadvantaged kids to a lesser standard of care.

Dental therapists are frequently cited as making dental care more affordable. But insurers and the states pay set fees for dental procedures no matter who performs them. In spite of having introduced dental therapists seven years ago, only <u>43 percent</u> of Minnesota children with Medicaid visited a dentist in the past year compared to 48 percent nationally.

These programs are too expensive to survive without subsidies and mirror the Canadian program, which failed once government subsidies ended. Instead of having another provider to drill and fill teeth, we should better connect patients with a fully-trained doctor of dentistry, utilizing the existing dental workforce.

The Community Dental Health Coordinator (CDHC), a community health worker, is a better option. They provide oral health education, disease prevention, help coordinate appointments, and can reduce patient no-show rates from nearly 50 percent to below 10 percent.

Increasing access to care isn't about increasing the number of providers; it's about providing the right care by the right provider at the right time.

Myth/Fact about Dentistry in Maryland and Dental Therapists

- MYTH: There aren't enough dentists to care for everybody in Maryland.
- FACT: Maryland has the 8th highest number of dentists per capita in the United States. In addition, there are approximately 130 new dentists graduating from the University of Maryland School of Dentistry every year.
- MYTH: Dental care is too expensive. Low-income Marylanders simply can't afford it.
- FACT: Dentists across Maryland provide care through venues of all sorts. In fact, 97 percent of all children enrolled in Healthy Smiles live within 15 minutes of a Medicaid dentists. Many see patients in their offices at low or no cost, participate in Mission of Mercy events at 4 locations across the state just this year, and have regular visits in elderly care facilities.
- MYTH: Dental therapists will provide less expensive care for the same procedures.
- FACT: Procedures cost the same amount to the patient—and the state—no matter who performs them. The problem is inadequate insurance coverage and a tattered safety net that fails to serve the population in need.
- MYTH: It's completely safe for non-dentists to pull a tooth.
- FACT: Pulling a tooth is an irreversible surgery, and is not always a simple procedure. A tooth extraction can become an emergency in seconds. Dentists are doctors with comprehensive training best suited to safely treat patients with other complex issues. Dental Therapists will not have the same high level of training.
- MYTH: Dental therapists can allow dentists to work on more complicated cases.
- FACT: Many, if not most, of the patients who may see a dental therapist have some of the most complex cases because of their lack of dental care over a period of time. A dental therapist wouldn't be able to treat many of these cases, and patients would be relegated to a lesser standard of care than they need.
- MYTH: Dentists won't take Medicaid patients, so we need to find an alternative way to help.
- FACT: The infrastructure is already in place as 97 percent of children enrolled in the Healthy Smiles program in Maryland live within 15 minutes of a Medicaid dentist. In addition, Maryland dentists provide millions of dollars in free or discounted care each year at their own practices and at events like the Mission of Mercy programs across the state.
- MYTH: Dental therapists are having success in other states and countries.
- FACT: Dental therapists have failed to make measurable improvements to oral health in underserved communities. Some dentists found them to be unprepared to treat patients. Less than 50 percent of Medicaid children in Minnesota, where Dental Therapists have been working for nearly ten years had a dental visit last year. Minnesota adults are still seeking dental treatment in emergency rooms, costing taxpayers an estimated \$148 million over the most recent three years for which information is available.

MYTH: Maryland dentists don't have any solutions.

FACT: Maryland dentists are already pioneering some of the most innovative ideas in the country. A Western Maryland program utilizing Community Dental Health Coordinators (CDHC), or Community Health Workers as they are often referred, has produced real results, providing patients access to fully trained dentists and saving millions of dollars over 5 years-without creating a second-tier provider. The CDHC works with the local emergency department to help ensure appropriate and cost-effective care for low-income patients who visit emergency rooms for tooth pain, and help coordinate a continuum of care for the patient to avoid future emergency room visits.




